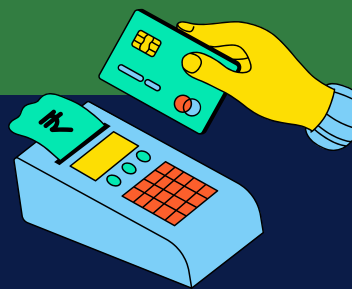


Passport and Travel Documents:

Ireland uses Type G plugs, so a universal adapter keeps devices charged for capturing memories or staying connected via smartphone throughout your trip.

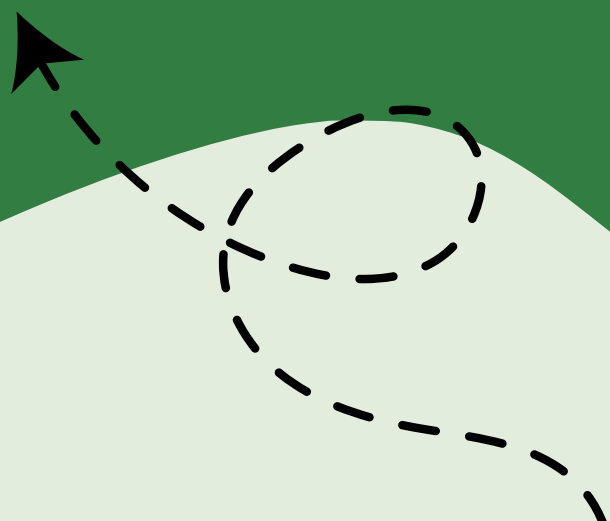
Daypack:

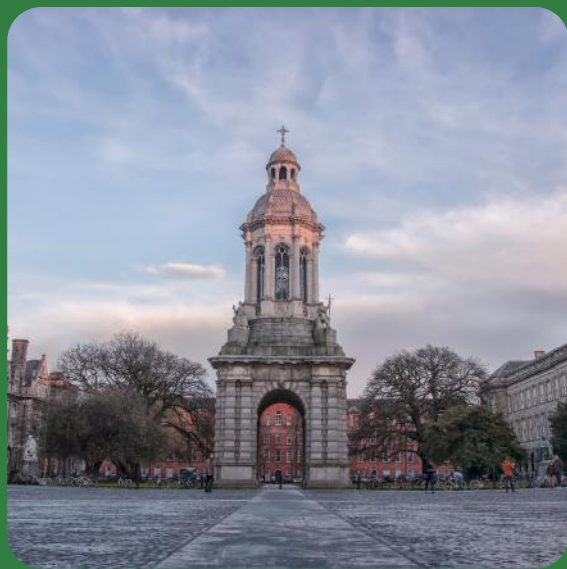


Explore the Cliffs of Moher

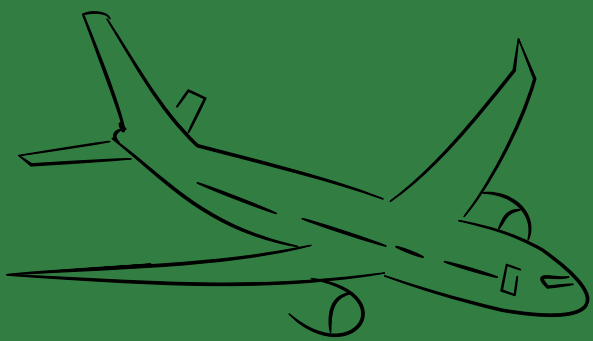
Visit Dublin's Trinity College

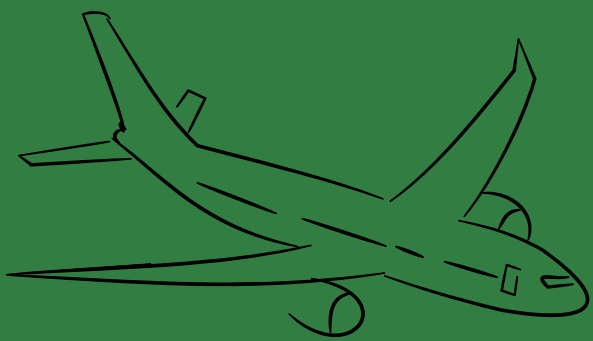

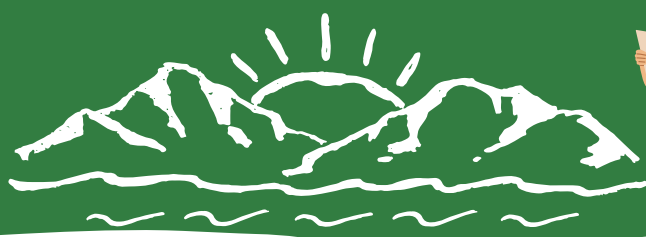
